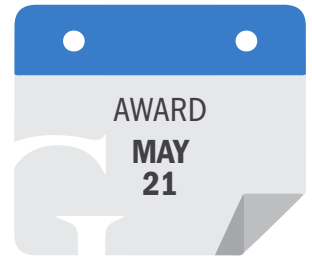

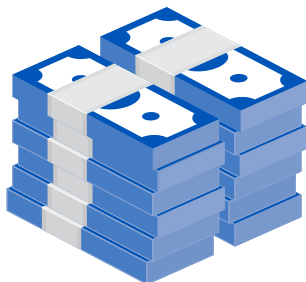
### APPLICANT ELIGIBILITY

#### Each applicant must:

- ✓ Be a member of Guardian Credit Union with at least a savings and checking account prior to submitting an application.
- ✓ Be a senior in High School or Undergraduate in college.
- ✓ Be enrolled full-time (minimum of twelve [12] credit hours) in a college or university for the fall 2019 semester. Students studying for their Masters or Doctorates are ineligible.
- ✓ Submit a transcript of high school grades (if high school senior) or most recent college transcript (if a college freshman, sophomore or junior).
- ✓ Not be a former recipient of a Guardian Credit Union Scholarship.

## HOW TO ENTER

Complete Scholarship packet and email to Guardian Credit Union on or before Tuesday, April 30th. Any scholarship packets submitted after April 30<sup>th</sup> will not be considered.

### Scholarship packet includes:

- ✓ Completed Application
- ✓ Essay answering the question: Discuss an accomplishment, event, or realization that sparked a period of personal growth and a new understanding of yourself or others in 300-500 words.
- ✓ One letter of recommendation from someone other than a family member.
- ✓ Report Card or College Transcript including a cumulative GPA.
- ✓ Letter of acceptance to college of choice.
- ✓ Office name and address in which Scholarship funds should be dispersed to.

## DISBURSEMENT OF SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

- ✓ The scholarship recipients will receive proceeds for the Fall 2019 semester.
- ✓ A check will be issued directly to the appropriate department/office at the educational institution identified by the recipient.
- ✓ The funds may be used for any educational-related expenses provided these expenses can be paid directly through the financial aid office.

The Sponsors reserve the right, in their sole discretion, to disqualify any applicant found to be: (1) violating The Scholarship Rules & Regulations; (b) tampering or attempting to tamper with the entry or voting process or the operation of The Scholarship Program; (c) acting in an unsportsmanlike or disruptive manner, or with intent to annoy, abuse, threaten or harass any other person or the credit union.
